



In San Francisco, passing woman Jeanne Bonnet leads an allwoman gang of former prostitutes who swear off men and support themselves through theft and shoplifting. In 1876, Bonnet was murdered by an angry pimp while sleeping

pimp while sleeping with her lover, Blanche

1878

"Mrs. Nash," a laundress with the 7th US Cavalry who had several soldier husbands, dies in the Dakota Territory and is revealed to have been a man. Her last husband, a corporal, committed suicide after the revelation.

1886

We'Wha, an accomplished Zuni Weaver and potter, is two spirit – born male but living as a woman. She spends six months in Washington, DC, and meets President Grover Cleveland, who never realizes this sixfoot Zuni maiden was born male.






